Participating in this event is the 2<sup>ND</sup> US Cav, Co A / 9<sup>TH</sup> VA Cav, Co D A. They are dedicated to portraying both U.S. and Confederate mounted troopers in the Civil War. The 2<sup>ND</sup> U.S. was engaged here on the lower Peninsula, twenty Medal of Honors were awarded to members of the 2<sup>ND</sup>. The 9<sup>TH</sup> fought in notable campaigns as the Seven Days and Gettysburg.

In addition to the Cavalry demo's, these events normally have live demonstrations of Artillery, Infantry, Medical Services, and Camp Life. Interacting with reenactment participants is highly encouraged. Great experience for the children/grandchildren and opportune photo ops.
